

# PGx975 PowerG Wireless Vanishing Door/Window Contact



#### **Overview**


It has come to our attention that due to improper re-assembly of the plastic portion of the PGx975 PowerG Wireless Vanishing Door/Window Contact, there is a possibility that the tamper switch of the device could become damaged, to the point where it may not properly detect a tamper condition when the case is opened, or constantly show a tamper condition even when the device is assembled.

## **Re-Assembly Instructions**

To ensure that the PGx975 plastic is properly re-assembled at the time of installation or when the battery is replaced, please follow the instructions below. The re-assembly instructions will also be updated in the Installation Manual.

To close the cover, complete the following steps (also seen in the image below)

- 1. Insert the two teeth on the front cover into the corresponding slots on the base.
- 2. When the cover is at a 30-degree angle to the base, push it into place until you hear a click.
