

## PowerSeries – Configuring Partitions

### Panels:

PC5010 (Power832)

### Overview:

The Power832 supports two partitions.

Configuring partitions is a three-step process:

- Enable partition 2
- Assign zones to partition 1
- Assign zones to partition 2

### Program Sections:

Section [201]	Partition 2 Enable
Section [202] – [205]	Partition 1 Zone Assignment
Section [206] – [209]	Partition 2 Zone Assignment

#### Step 1 – Partition 2 Enable

To enable Partition 2, turn Option [1] ON in Section [201].

#### Step 2 – Partition 1 Zone Enable

At default, zones 1 – 8 are enabled on Partition 1. If zones 9 to 32 are being used, the zones must be enable before they will operate. To enable a zone on Partition 1, turn ON the appropriate option in the correct section.

Section [202]	– Partition 1 zones 1 to 8 enable/disable
Section [203]	– Partition 1 zones 9 to 16 enable/disable
Section [204]	– Partition 1 zones 17 to 24 enable/disable
Section [205]	– Partition 1 zones 25 to 32 enable/disable

**Note:** If zone 1 – 8 are not required on Partition 1, turn OFF the appropriate option in section [202].

#### Step 3 – Partition 2 Zone Enable

To enable a zone on Partition 2, turn ON the appropriate option in the correct Section.

Section [206]	– Partition 2 zones 1 to 8 enable/disable
Section [207]	– Partition 2 zones 9 to 16 enable/disable
Section [208]	– Partition 2 zones 17 to 24 enable/disable
Section [209]	– Partition 2 zones 25 to 32 enable/disable

**Note:** Zones assigned to both partitions are called ‘common’ zones and will only be armed if both partitions are armed.

**Technical Tips:**

1. At default, zones 1 to 8 are assigned to partition 1. If any of these zones are required to be on partition 2 only, they must be disabled on partition 1.
2. To verify zones on partition 2 are functioning properly, a keypad must be loaned or assigned to partition 2.
3. A keypad assigned or loaned to partition 2 will not function (no keypad beeps, no ready, arm or zone lights) unless partition 2 is enabled.
4. If a zone does not go into alarm, it may be assigned to both partitions (common zone).

**Quick Test:**

Violate each zone assigned to partition 1 and partition 2 and ensure each is displayed on the correct partition keypad. Common zones should display on both partition keypads.
